Only for starting and surveillance of the tractor pump while it is running, ordering stopping if there are problems in the parts controlled by the probes.

Designed to be installed also on board the machine.

- All technical interventions must be performed with the engine stationary and with terminal 50 of the starter motor disconnected

- To safeguard persons and equipment, before connecting an external battery charger, disconnect the plant electrical terminals from the battery poles.

The installer has the task of checking that the disturbance levels are within the requirements of the standards.

CONDUCTION AND MAINTENANCE

The following maintenance operations should be performed every week:

- Check that the indicators function.
- Check the batteries.
- Check that the indicators are tight, check the condition of the terminals.

OIL AND BATTERY INDICATORS

On when key is turned to "AUT", off when the engine is running with correct oil pressure and battery charging.

ANOMALY INDICATOR

Enabled after the lighting up of the ENGINE PROTECTIONS ACTIVE () visual indicator, they light up when an anomaly is detected.

ENGINE PROTECTIONS

The engine protections are enabled after the lighting up of the ENGINE PROTECTIONS ACTIVE visual indicator (20 seconds after turning the key to "AUT" or, in any case, 20 seconds after the start impulse).



The protection probe (mounted on the engine) interventions, shown by the relevant visual indicators, stop the engine. They can be divided into two groups:

Immediately for: 3 second delay for:

OIL PRESSURE SWITCH



- COOLING LIQUID LEVEL PROBE



OVER-HEATING THERMOSTAT



BATTERY CHARGE ALTERNATOR - + (BROKEN ALTERNATOR BELT)



OPERATION

PUMP PROTECTION

The pump protection is enabled (after 3 minutes, which can be regulated, this being the time needed for the water to be pressurized) when the PUMP PROTECTION ACTIVE () lights up.

When the pressure is correct the relevant indicator lights up.



The intervention of the protection (5 seconds after the lowering of the pressure detected by the pump water pressure switch) stops the engine, it is memorized and the visual indication INSUFFICIENT PUMP WATER PRESSURE is shown.

RESET: Turn the ignition key to zero.

TRACTOR AND PUMP STOPPAGE

This is achieved in two ways:

- Turning the ignition key to zero.
- When protections intervene.


Stopping occurs:

- Disconnecting the supply to the SOLENOID which closes the gasoline passage.





TROUBLE SHOOTING

TYPE OF PROBLEM	PROBABLE CAUSES	REMEDIES
STARTER MOTOR DOES NOT FUNCTION	- Flat battery	- Charge battery and clean connection terminals
	- Defective starter motor	- Check that +12V reach terminal 50 of starting motor during start phase. Check and, if necessary, replace starter relay
	- An anomaly indicator lights up	- See page 10 (ENGINE STOP FOR ANOMALY)
	- Defective ignition key	- Replace ignition key, check fastons that secure it
STARTER MOTOR	- Lack of fuel	- Fill tank
FUNCTIONS BUT ENGINE DOES NOT START	- Fuel supply circuit defect	- Check function of stop system - Consult tractor manual instructions
STOP FOR ENGINE ANOMALY	- Low cooling liquid indicator lights up	- Check cooling liquid level
	- Broken belt indicator lights up after ENGINE PROTECTIONS ACTIVE indicator lights up	- Check alternator belt
	- Low oil pressure indicator lights up after ENGINE PROTECTIONS OACTIVE indicator lights up	- Check engine oil level

	- Defective engine probe	- Test probe (see ENGINE PROBE TEST on page 5) and, if necessary, replace them
ENGINE STOPS THOUGH ALL APPEARS	- Fuse(s) blown (inside junction box)	- Replace fuses with similar ones
TO BE OK	- Low cooling liquid indicator lights up	- Check probe, clean and, if necessary, replace it
	- Broken belt indicator lights up after ENGINE PROTECTIONS ACTIVE	- Check charge alternator function
	- Low oil pressure indicator lights up after ENGINE PROTECTIONS ACTIVE	- Test and, if necessary, replace oil pressure switch




